## **Program Description**

• Continuing & Professional Studies

The BS in Health Insurance Management is a specialized program that provides a comprehensive understanding of health insurance management. This program is unique in its focus on the health insurance industry, offering an innovative educational model that examines health insurance from the perspectives of both payers and providers.

The curriculum encompasses the following core content areas:

- Health insurance: This area focuses on the principles and practices of health insurance, including policy design, underwriting, and claims management.

- Healthcare finance and reimbursement: This component covers financial management in healthcare organizations and the principles of healthcare reimbursement.
