This course serves as a capstone course in the Health Studies program.

Students complete the SCPS Portfolio they have been assembling throughout their program. The portfolio provides students with an opportunity to look at the past, present, and future. Students reflect on personal growth and development during their program of study. Students also demonstrate the ability to integrate theory and practice by proposing a solution to a current problem in a professional setting via a research project. The portfolio concludes with a future directions essay wherein students identify goals for continued professional growth and lifelong learning.
